- 1. Call to Order The meeting was called to order at 10:15 AM by Chairperson Kain
- 2. Approval of minutes

Upon a motion by Rohrscheib and seconded by Ellis the minutes from the previous meeting, June 11th was approved unanimously.

## 3. Approval of Special Event Permits

a. Fireworks after Meet Me on the Island – July 5<sup>th</sup> Cathy Dietz is working with the county on the closure of the Jefferson bridge. This is the same set up as Best Week Ever. The were no issues. Traffic and lighting will drop cones for them to close off.

Upon a motion by Robrscheib and seconded by Ellis, the permit is approved unanimously on two contingences: St. Joe County approval for the Jefferson bridge closure and Cathy Dietz is to pay the full portion of the expedited application fee due to late submission. Amount owed \$50.00.

Suggestions were made to change route slightly to turn west on Western and head south on Taylor and east on South to avoid a dead-end traffic jam.
