

Historic Preservation Commission of South Bend:

I am contacting you today on behalf of my sister, Doreen K. Mesecar, owner of the property located at 517 Edgewater Drive in South Bend – within the Edgewater Place Historic District. She is applying for a Certificate of Appropriateness and asking for permission to remove two trees on her property. Included with this removal will be the grounding of the roots, replacement of the trees as well as removal and replacement of the sidewalk located in front of the property and driveway.

I have attached the following documents for your review:

- 1) Application for Certificate of Appropriateness
- 2) Description of Project
- 3) Permission for removal and replacement of the trees from the Forester
- 4) Quote from approved Licensed Arborist (Above and Beyond Tree and Shrubbery Service)
- 5) Pictures of Trees and sidewalk damage
  - A) Tree #1 is to the right side of the house and as it was planted very close to the house the roots are compromising the foundation.
  - B) Tree #2 is located in front of the house between the street and the sidewalk. Its roots has caused extensive damage to the sidewalk in front of the house as well as the sidewalk of the driveway. It is a hazard to anyone using the sidewalk and is a potential liability to the property owner. It is ecstatically outside of the requirements of the neighborhood. It is difficult to maintain during snow removal. The sidewalk damage to the driveway is now affecting cars as they go over it with potential damage to the underside of the vehicles.

As you will see from the documentation above; with your permissions we will proceed as follows:

We will sign the contract with the licensed arborist and secure a date for the trees to be removed. We will sign a contract with the approved construction company to secure a date for the sidewalk removal. The constructor's contract and the proper paperwork will then be sent to the City Sidewalk Division for approval for the sidewalk removal/replacement to begin. Upon receiving their approval we will schedule the construction company to take the sidewalk out. We will then have the trees removed and the roots grounded. The construction company will come back and replace the sidewalk according to the city's standards. The city will then inspect and give their final approval on the completion of the project. We will replace the trees within the time limit given to us by the Forester.

It is our desire to move forward with this project as quickly as we can to ensure that this is done before the winter season. We are hoping to garner approval at your September committee meeting, which I believe to be on the third Monday of every month. (September 16<sup>th</sup>)

I appreciate your consideration and taking the time to review our request. #### **DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT**

The intent of this project is removal of two trees on the property of 517 Edgewater Drive, South Bend 46601 and the replacement of the damaged sidewalk in front of the property and driveway. We are asking for the Historic Society to provide us with a Certificate of Appropriateness to move forward with our project.

The city Forester, Brent Thompson, has been out to the property and attached you will find his approval for the removal of the trees. We have been given a list of the appropriate tree replacements from the South Bend Parks Department and have been advised that we have up to one year to replace said trees upon approval of the Historic Society.


Attached you will find the quote from "Above and Beyond Tree Service" on the work that they will be doing. A contract will be signed as soon as the Historic Society issues their approval certificate as a non-refundable deposit is required to sign the contract.

Also attached you will find picture(s) of the damaged sidewalk in front of the house and driveway. We talked to the Department of Public Works Engineering Department – and were sent to the City Sidewalk and Curb Replacement division. There we spoke to Marcia Qualls. She sent us the paperwork for the City Sidewalk Program along with a list of city approved construction business. We have requested a quote on the cement work from "Construction By Dave" and are expecting that quote this week. Marcia has advised us to inform you that we are working with her. Upon receipt of the Historic Society approval, we will then file the proper documentation with them to proceed with the removal and replacement of the sidewalk/driveway entrance according to the city's standards.

The dimensions of the sidewalk being replaced is 5' X 26'. It is our understanding that the city will be inspecting before the project begins and will take pictures. They will also inspect after the work is done to give final approval that it meets the city's required codes. The cement company will follow due diligence in working with the city on the proper codes and schedule of the work being done.

This picture is from a 2007 photo on Google Maps. I could not get an aerial view of the property.

The width of the lot is approximately 44 feet wide from the grass off of the driveway to the property line.

Looking at the house from this view, Tree #1 is directly left of the side of the house. The dimension from the house to the end of her property line is approximately 6 feet. The tree was planted at approximately 3 feet from the side of the house.

Looking at the house from this view, Tree #2 is to the right of the house in the parcel of land the is between the street and the sidewalk. The area is 9' X 20'. This photo is from 2007. Recent photos show the damage to the sidewalk in front of the house and driveway.

Sec. 19-19. Removal of hazardous trees by property owner; order, notice; emergency, removal.

- (a) Every owner of real estate within the City shall remove or trim any tree or shrub or any part thereof located on such real estate or in the tree and lawn area in front of such real estate which may be dead, diseased, unsightly, in a condition which is injurious or detrimental to the public health and safety or the growth of adjacent trees or which may project over the public street on which such real estate abuts in such manner as to obstruct the free passage of pedestrians and vehicular traffic on such public streets.
- (b) The Board of Park Commissioners shall have the power and the authority to order and require such owner to remove any such tree or shrub by first causing notice to be served on such owner in the manner provided in section 19-21 not less than ten (10) days prior to the time designated in such notice for the removal or trimming of such tree or shrub.
- (c) In case of an immediate necessity for any such removal or trimming by reason of storm or other emergency, such removal or trimming may be done by the Board of Park Commissioners of its Superintendent of Parks, and no notice whatever need be given thereof.

Sec. 19-15. The Board of Park Commissioners shall have the right, power and authority to:

(1) Require the owners of parcels of land bordering on any public street of the City to grade, sod, plant, and maintain in proper condition the tree lawn area and the street centers in front of the parcels of land. (2) Require such owners to plant and maintain shade or ornamental trees in such areas.

Sec. 19-17. Tree and lawn area regulations. Standards for planting trees and shrubs. No tree or shrub shall be planted in a tree and lawn area having a width of less than five (5) feet. No hedge or shrubbery planted in the tree and lawn areas shall be permitted to grow more than three (3) feet in height. All trees planted in such areas shall be of healthy stock, not less than two (2) inches in caliper, and the lowest limbs of such trees shall not be less than ten (10) feet above the curb and sidewalk. No tree shall be planted less than thirty-five (35) feet from another tree. No tree or shrub in such areas of street intersections shall be planted less than fifteen (15) feet from the intersection of the curbs. No person shall plant trees within six (6) feet of a fire hydrant or in such manner as to obstruct the view of any streetlight, traffic sign, signal device or street intersection.


