CITY OF SOUTH BEND ACCESSORY DWELLING UNIT APPLICATION

STANDARDS

- 1. An Ancillary Dwelling Unity (ADU) must be subordinate and incidental to a primary building on the same lot.
- 2. An ADU unit may be detached or attached to the primary building. Only one ADU is allowed per lot.
- 3. Finished floor area of an ADU shall be no more than 75% of the finished floor area of the primary dwelling or 800 square feet, whichever is less.
- 4. An ADU shall not be taller in feet than the primary building on the lot and meet all height requirements.
- 5. In a S1, U1, or U2 district, the owner(s) of the lot upon which the ADU is located shall occupy at least one of the dwelling units.
