The City of South Bend will adopt one of its largest budgets in history at roughly \$381 million dollars. Residents living West of the St. Joe River and in historically underserved communities have repeatedly asked the Common Council and James Mueller's administration to share how much of the budget is going to their neighborhoods to no avail.
