

All nine thousand (9,000) lights are expected to be converted by Fall 2022. A neighborhood streetlight survey is available at [southbendin.gov/LED](http://southbendin.gov/LED).

Councilmember Sharon L. McBride asked if priority would be based on safety and accidents at intersections.

Eric Horvath responded that the Mayor asked the Department to consider gaps, like those identified through Light Up South Bend. After the major replacement, these will be addressed.
