No. 18, 1903

RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS OF THE CITY OF SOUTH BEND, INDIANA: That it is desirable to vacate the following:

The alley lying East of Lot #1 and the alley lying between Lots #2 & #3 in E. Petition of Studebaker Brothers Manufacturing Company
for vacation of short-narrow street in E Tutts Addition.

Your petitioners the Studebaker Brothers Manufacturing Company, would respectfully represent to your honorable Board - that heretofore, on the 24th day of January AD 1888, for a nominal consideration of one dollar, they - the said Company - did convey by their deed of that date, recorded in Deed Record Vol 77 page 619, in the Recorder's Office of St Joseph County Ind, to the City of South Bend - a strip of land twenty (20) feet wide East and West by one hundred and thirty two 1/2 feet long, North and South taken off of the west side of Lot No three (3) in Elliot Tutts Addition to the City of South Bend, for street purposes exclusively.

1st A That since the execution and delivery of their said deed to the City, said Company, has acquired most of the real estate in the immediate vicinity, and said street has ceased to be of public benefit or utility to any general extent, and the alleys now on the west and parallel with said street, furnish all of the outlets now required, for the limited use now made by the public, and there does not appear to be any further need of said street, nor of keeping open and maintaining said 20 foot street.

That said street was donated to the City by

That since the execution and delivery of their said deed
to the City, said Company, has acquired most of
the real estate in the immediate vicinity, and
said street has ceased to be of public benefit or
utility to any general extent, and the alleys
now on the west and parallel with said street, furnish
all of the outlets now required for the limited use
now made by the public, and there does not appear
to be any further need of said street, nor of keeping
open and maintaining said 20 foot street.

That said street was donated to the City by
your petitioners, at a time when it was supposed
that said street would prove to be of general

public benefit, but that it has since proven otherwise, and has mainly been used by your petitioners as a private street.

And your petitioners state, that it would be to the mutual advantage of the City and your petitioners to close said street, and to legally vacate the same, A plot is herewith attached showing the location of said street.

Wherefore, your petitioners would respectfully request, that your honorable body take all such steps and proceedings in the matter, as are required by law to vacate the same as a public street, and they will ever pray &c

And your petitioners would further respectfully represent to your honorable body, that they are owners of Lots Nos One, two, three and four (1, 2, 3 & 4)

in said Elliot Tratts Addition to the City, and to all land lying north of, and on opposite side of Robertson's Street, in Robertson's Addition, heretofore vacated, and they would say that the east end of said

Robertson Street is no longer of public utility or public benefit, and that all land on the north & East, and South sides of Robertson Street lying East of the West line of said lot No Four (4), extended across said street is owned by your petitioners and surrounds said street. Your petitioners would therefore respectfully request your honorable body to take such legal and proper proper proceedings as may be required, to

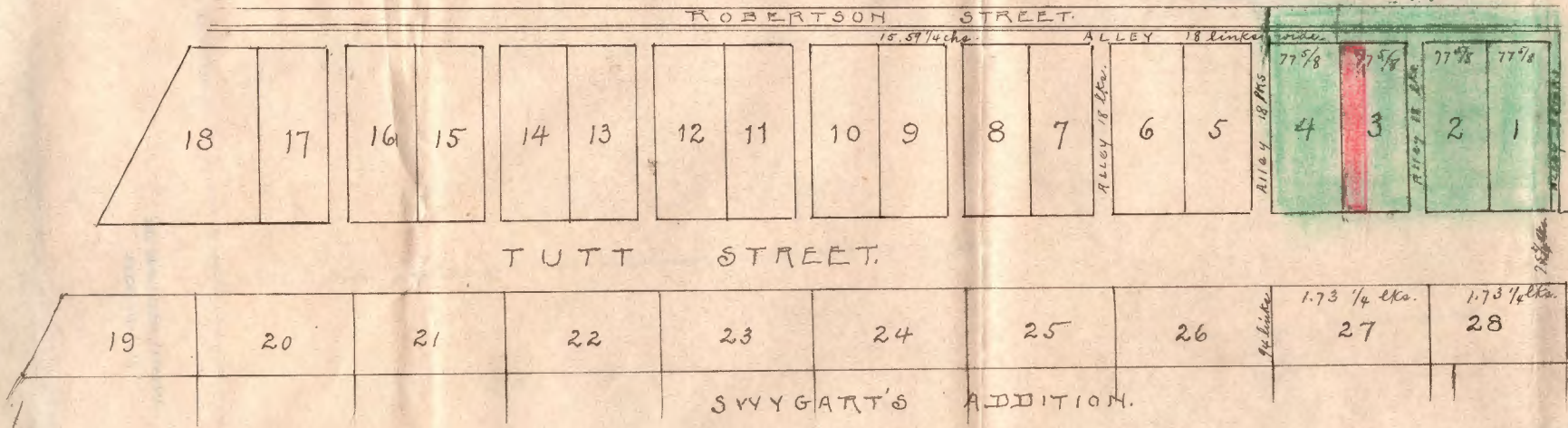
