COPY OF VACATION RESOLUTION.

No. 19, 1903

RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS OF THE CITY OF SOUTH BEND, INDIANA: That it is desirable to vacate the following:

The first alley south of Tisdale Cor. and between Caroline Street and Kline Street, running east and west. Also the alley extending south from said first alley to another alley lying next north of the right of way of the Lake Shore and Michigan Southern Railway Company's tracks and midway between said Caroline and Kline Street. Said alleys lying in Henry Lane Sub-Division in the City of South Bend and Kline Addition to the City of South Bend

The following property may be injuriously or beneficially effected by such vacation:

All of lots 10 - 11 - 12 - 13 - 14 - 15 - 16 in Henry Lane Sub-Division and all of lots 1 - 2 - 3 - 4 - 10 - 11 and 12 in Kline Addition to the City of South Bend.

Notice of this resolution shall be published on the 29 day of June and on the 6 day of July 1903, in the South Bend Daily Tribune.

This Board, at its office in the City Hall on the 10 day of July 1903, at 4:30 p. m. will hear and receive remonstrances from all persons interested in or affected by these proceedings.

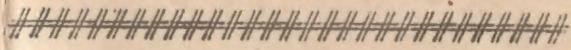

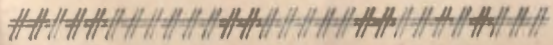
PETITION

VACATION OF ALLEY

AND

The widening of another alley.



TO THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS

-- of--

THE CITY OF SOUTH BEND.

THE UNDERSIGNED freeholders respectfully petition your honorable body to vacate the following alleys in said city, to wit;

First; The first alley south of Vistula Avenue and between Caroline Street on the east and Kline Street on the west,

Second; The alley extending south from said first alley to another alley lying next north of the right of way of the Lake Shore and Michigan Southern Railroad and midway between said Caroline and Kline Streets. The east part of said two alleys hereby asked to be vacated lie in Henry Leers Addition to said City and the west part in Klines Addition to said City. All of which will fully appear by reference to the map hereto annexed.

The portions of alleys proposed to be vacated are enclosed with red lines, and which map also shows the surrounding locality and the names of the owners of the adjoining properties.

That your petitioner Joseph B. Arnold owns all of the lots and real estate adjoining said alleys, being all of the lots lying between said Caroline Street on the east and Kline Street on the west and between said Vistula Avenue on the north and the alley next south of said Railroad on the south comprising fourteen lots. That said alleys have never been used as such and are of no public benefit and it would be to the advantage of said city to vacate them and thereby avoid opening and maintaining them.

And your petitioner further asks that the alley above referred to lying next north of said Railroad and between said Caroline and Kline Streets be widened twenty two feet by taking a strip of

land twenty two feet in width off of the whole length of the Southerly sides of lot Sixteen in Henry Leers said Addition and of lot Twelve in Klines said Addition thus making said alley 36 feet wide and thus constituting it an extention of Leer Court

That said lots 12 and 16 are owned by Joseph B. Arnold. All of which will also appear by reference to said annexed map, the part of said lots asked to be so appropriated are bounded on said map with greenink, and which map also shows the surrounding locality and the name of owners of the adjoining properties.

That the amount of ground which the city will acquire by the widening of said last alley is a little more than that lost to the city by the vacation of said two alleys, but said Joseph B. Arnold hereby consents that the benefits arising to him by the vacation of said two alleys shall be equal to the damage sustained by him in the widening of said other alley 22 feet.

The converting of said alley into a street will improve and benefit the city and be beneficial to the public.

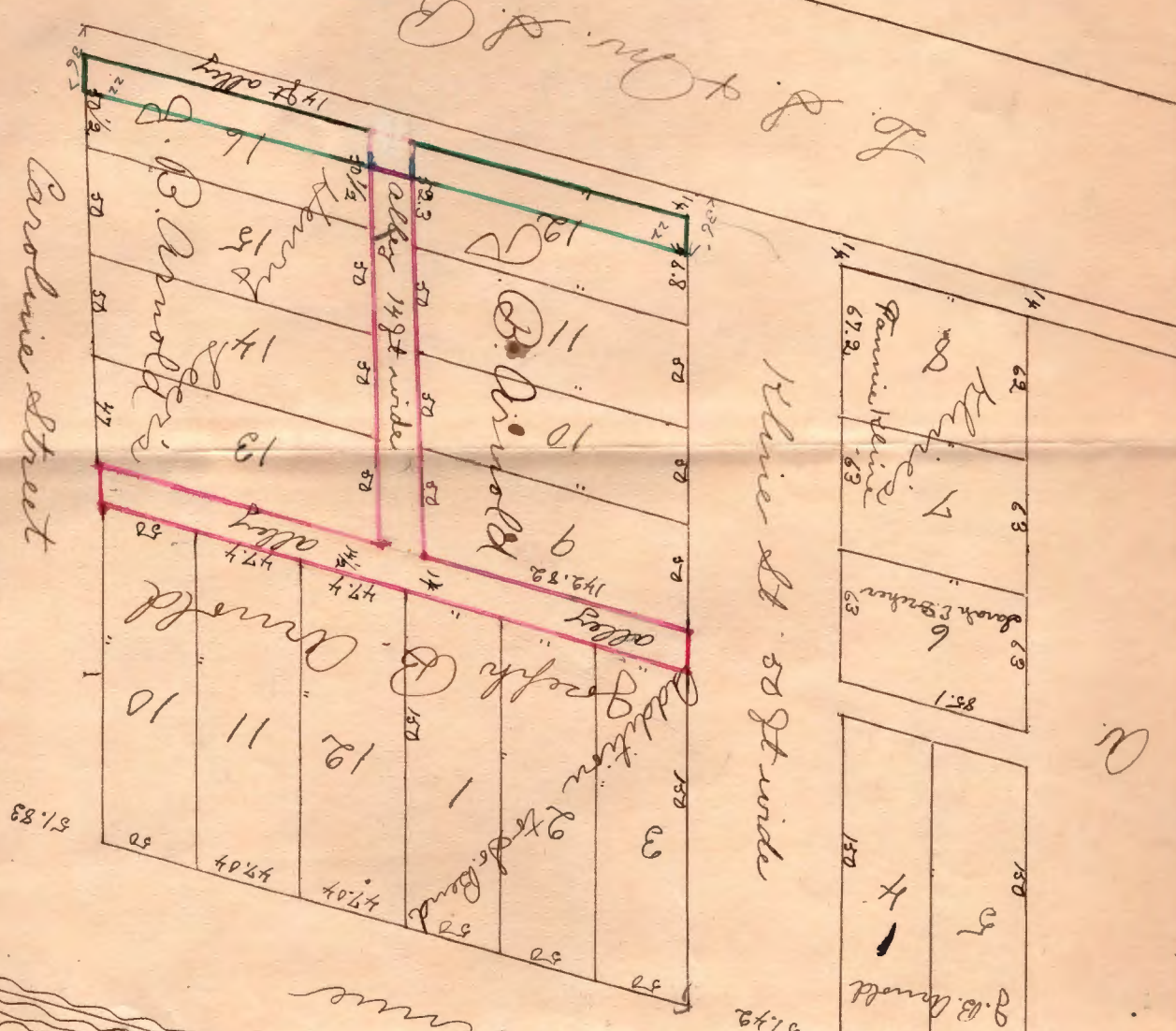
