TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS


OF THE CITY OF SOUTH BEND, Indiana:

We, Andrew Anderson, Jeanie Putnam, and Emma DuShane respectfully represent to your Honorable Board that on the 15th day of April, 1904, Mary E. Anderson, now deceased, executed a plat of a subdivision of Bank Out Lot No. 117, and a part of Lot 355, in the Original Plat, all in the City of South Bend; that since that time Mrs. Mary E. Anderson has died, and your petitioners are each of them the owner of the undivided one-third of all of the land described in said plat; that none of the land embraced in said plat has been sold nor have the public entered into or taken possession of the highway therein nor has any improvement thereof been made, and no person except only your petitioners are interested in any way in the land or rights or privileges referred to, embraced in, or affected by the plat of said land.

Your petitioners represent that if said plat should remain on record and said land remain platted it would be impossible to provide a roadway across said bank out lot 117, from the end of Lamont Terrace to LaFayette Street, and that Lamont Terrace should be extended across to La Fayette Street and in order that said extension may hereafter be made your

petitioners pray that the said plat be vacated, and the street and alley therein.
