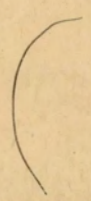

Petition of the Studebaker Brothers' Manufacturing Company for vacation of alley and portion of street.

The undersigned, Studebaker Brothers' Manufacturing Company, would respectfully petition your Board for the vacation of a certain short alley bounded on all sides by real property owned by them, and for the vacation of a portion of the East end of Robertson Street, bounded on the North, South and ~~West~~<sup>East</sup> by real property now owned by them, to-wit: \_\_\_\_\_

1st: The alley twelve (12) feet in width, that runs North from Tutt Street to Robertson Street, between Lots Nos. Four and Five (4 & 5) on the plat of Elliot Tutt's Addition to the City of South Bend.

2nd: That portion of Robertson Street lying North of the above alley and North of Lots Nos. Five and Six (5 & 6) in Elliot Tutt's Addition to the City of South Bend. \_\_\_\_\_

The whole territory requested to be vacated herein being more fully described by a line running as follows, viz: Beginning at the South East corner of said Lot No. Five (5) of Elliot Tutt's Addition aforesaid, thence East 12 feet to the South West corner of Lot No. Four (4) of said Addition; thence North about 167 feet to the North line of Robertson Street; thence West on said line about 126 46/100 feet to a point due North of the North West corner of Lot No. 6 of said Addition; thence South across Robertson Street 35 feet to said North West corner of Lot No. 6; thence East 114 46/100 feet to the North East corner of Lot No. 5; thence South 132 feet to South East corner of said Lot No. 5, at the place of beginning. \_\_\_\_\_

And your petitioners would represent that said alley and portion of street has ceased to be of general public utility or benefit, and is used mainly for the private uses of your petitioner; that the vacation prayed for would not prevent any of the owners lying West of



the territory to be vacated from having an outlet, and egress and ingress to and from, and between Tutt Street and Robertson Street, as now and heretofore enjoyed by them, the alley between Lots Nos. 6 and 7 being still open, and all of Robertson Street lying West of the West line of Lot No. 4 extended North to the North line of Robertson Street being left open to Prairie Avenue, and the general public would therefore in no manner be discommoded, or prevented from enjoying all the rights of passage-way that they at present enjoy; that your petitioners are proposing to make valuable improvements to their property to add to the taxable value of the City, and said vacation would materially aid them in so doing. Wherefore they pray.

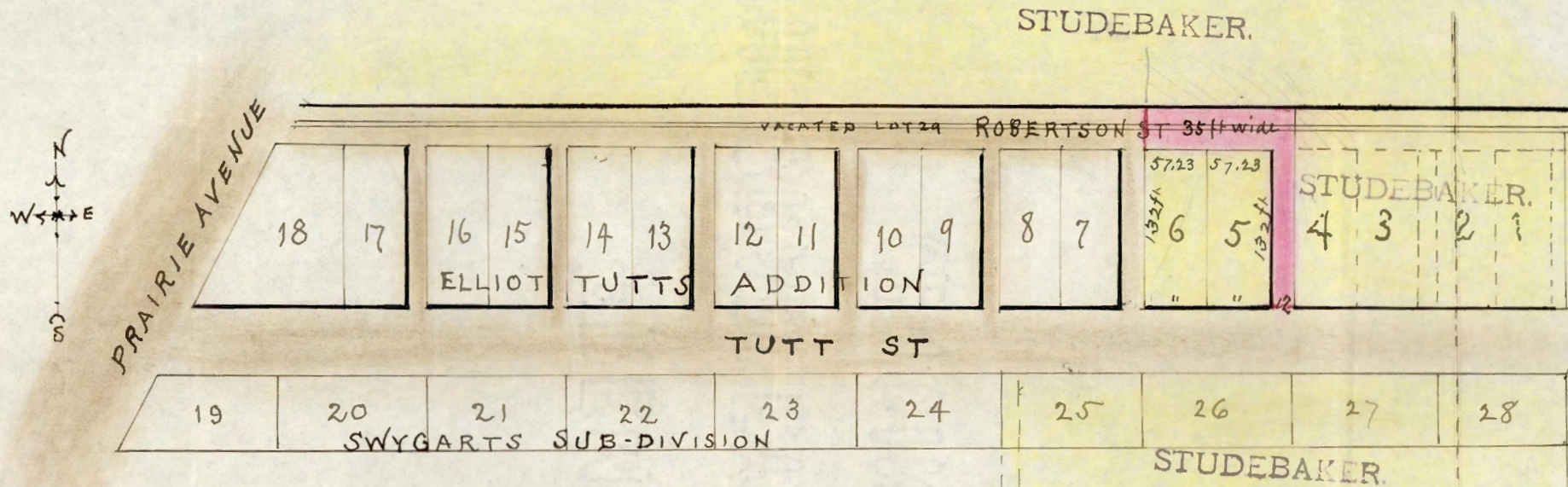
