RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS OF THE CITY OF SOUTH BEND, INDIANA: That it is desirable to vacate the following:

14 foot alley lying south and adjacent to lot 24 in Creeds 2nd Addition.

Also 7 foot alley described as follows: Begin at a point 10 feet south of the north west corner of lot 21 Creeds 2nd addition; thence south to a point 14 feet south of the south west corner of lot 24 Creeds 2nd addition; thence west 7 feet; thence north to a point west of beginning; thence east 7 feet to the place of beginning.


