PETITION.

South Bend, Indiana, June 15, 1911.

To the Honorable Board of Public Works
of the City of South Bend, Ind.

Gentlemen:--

We, the undersigned property owners, petition your honorable body to vacate the Public Alley which extends from the North line of East Colfax Avenue North one-half block to the first alley running East and West in Out Lot Fifteen (15) in Cottrell's Addition to Lowell, now a part of the City of South Bend; said lot Fifteen (15) being bounded on the North by Lasalle Avenue, on the East by Eddy Street, on the South by Colfax Avenue and on the West by Francis Street.

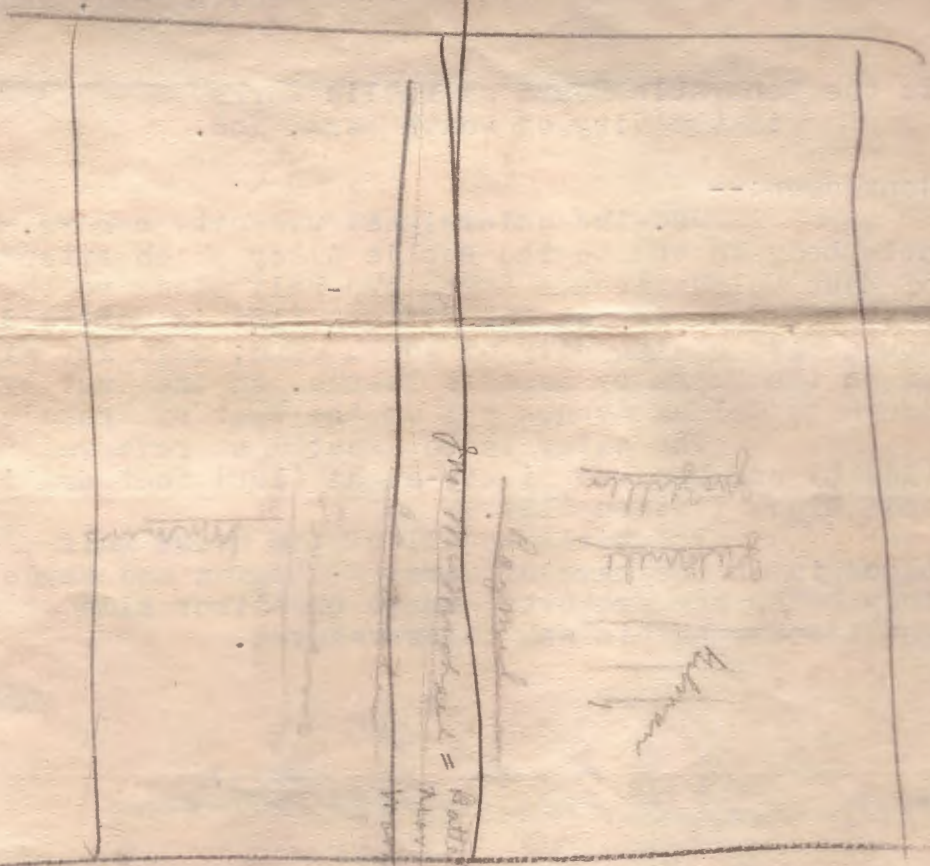
