VACATION RESOLUTION NO. 29.

Ginz Avenue (on the east side) is 20 ft. wide. It is the only available way for teams or vehicles to reach the dam on the east side and a vacant lot near the dam which is reserved and used for the deposit of material for repairs to the dam. Such repairs are almost invariably of an emergency nature, requiring the use of many teams for hauling material and incoming and outgoing teams must pass each other on Ginz Avenue. A width of 20 ft. leaves little room to spare for so doing.

Vacation resolution No. 29 of the Board of Public Works proposes to vacate 4 ft. of this width and the resolution is set for hearing on Wednesday, July 5th at 10 A. M.

The South Bend Manufacturing Co. (the Dam Co.) holds that the narrowing of Ginz Avenue to 16 ft. as proposed in the resolution would be a serious mistake and a detriment to the proper up-keep of its water power. It objects, therefore, to the adoption of the resolution unless the parties in whose favor the vacation is wanted will put in a substantial retaining wall, making its height something above the bank of the East Race, the entire length of the portion of the race affected which would permit driving closer and with safety nearer the bank of the race so that with care two teams could pass.

No personal reason exists for opposing the passage of the resolution and it is only as a matter of duty to water power users on both sides of the river that the objection is made.
