

To the Honorable Board of Public Works of the City of South Bend, Ind.

GENTLEMEN:-

We, the undersigned property owners, petition your honorable body to VACATE

all of that part of Scott Street lying East of Lots Nos. 6 and 7 excepting 30 feet off the South end of said Lot No. 7; all of Leon Court lying between said Lots Nos. 6 and 7 and all of the alley that lies North of said Lot No. 6, all as shown on the recorded plat of Raff's First Addition to the City of South Bend, St. Joseph County and State of Indiana.

Your petitioners would state to your honorable body that they are the owners in fee simple of said Lots Nos. 6 and 7 in Raff's First Addition aforesaid, and of all territory on the East and North of all to be vacated and they are desirous of utilizing all of said real estate now cut up into lots and separated by said streets and alley. That it is impossible to utilize said territory for their purposes with advantage unless the same be thrown together into single tracts.
