COPY OF VACATION RESOLUTION.

No. 39 1917, ~~1918~~

RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS OF THE CITY OF SOUTH BEND, INDIANA: That it is desirable to vacate the following: a part of Leer Court from Kline Street to Caroline Street as follows, to-wit:-

Beginning at the intersection of the west line of Caroline Street and the north line of Leer Court as now located; thence south on the west line of Caroline Street to a point 26 feet north of the northerly line of the right of way of the Lake Shore & Michigan Southern Railway Co., measured at right angles to the northerly line of said right of way; thence westerly parallel to the northerly line of said right of way to a point in the east line of Kline Street 26 feet north of the northerly line of said right of way measured at right angles to said right of way; thence north on the east line of Kline Street to the northerly line of Leer Court; thence easterly on the northerly line of Leer Court to the place of beginning.

The following property may be injuriously or beneficially effected by such vacation; Beginning at the intersection of the southerly line of Lincoln Way East and the east line of Kline Street; thence south on the east line of Kline Street to the southerly line of the right of way of the Lake Shore and Michigan Southern Railway Co., thence easterly on the southerly line of said right of way to the west line of Caroline Street; thence north on the west line of Caroline Street to the southerly line of Lincoln Way East; thence westerly on the southerly line of Lincoln Way East to the place of beginning.

Notice of this resolution shall be published on the 24th day of May 1917 and on the 31st day of May 1917, in the South Bend Daily Tribune.

This Board, at its office in the City Hall on the 5th day of June 1917 at 7:45 p. m. will hear and receive remonstrances from all persons interested in or affected by these proceedings.
