Gentlemen:


I herewith present petition for the vacation of the alley running from Scott Street to Prairie Ave., between two parcels of land owned by this Company; the parcel on which our present works are located and the parcel immediately adjoining us on the South, running to a point at the intersection of Scott Street and Prairie Ave.

All of the dwellings on this land will be removed from the premises and it is the intention of this Company to erect on the Prairie Avenue side of our holdings, a large garage and repair shop to take care of the automobile equipment of the Company. The size of the building will necessitate extending somewhat beyond the limits of the alley. The construction will be modern, of concrete and brick, and will be a decided improvement in the appearance of this section of the city.
