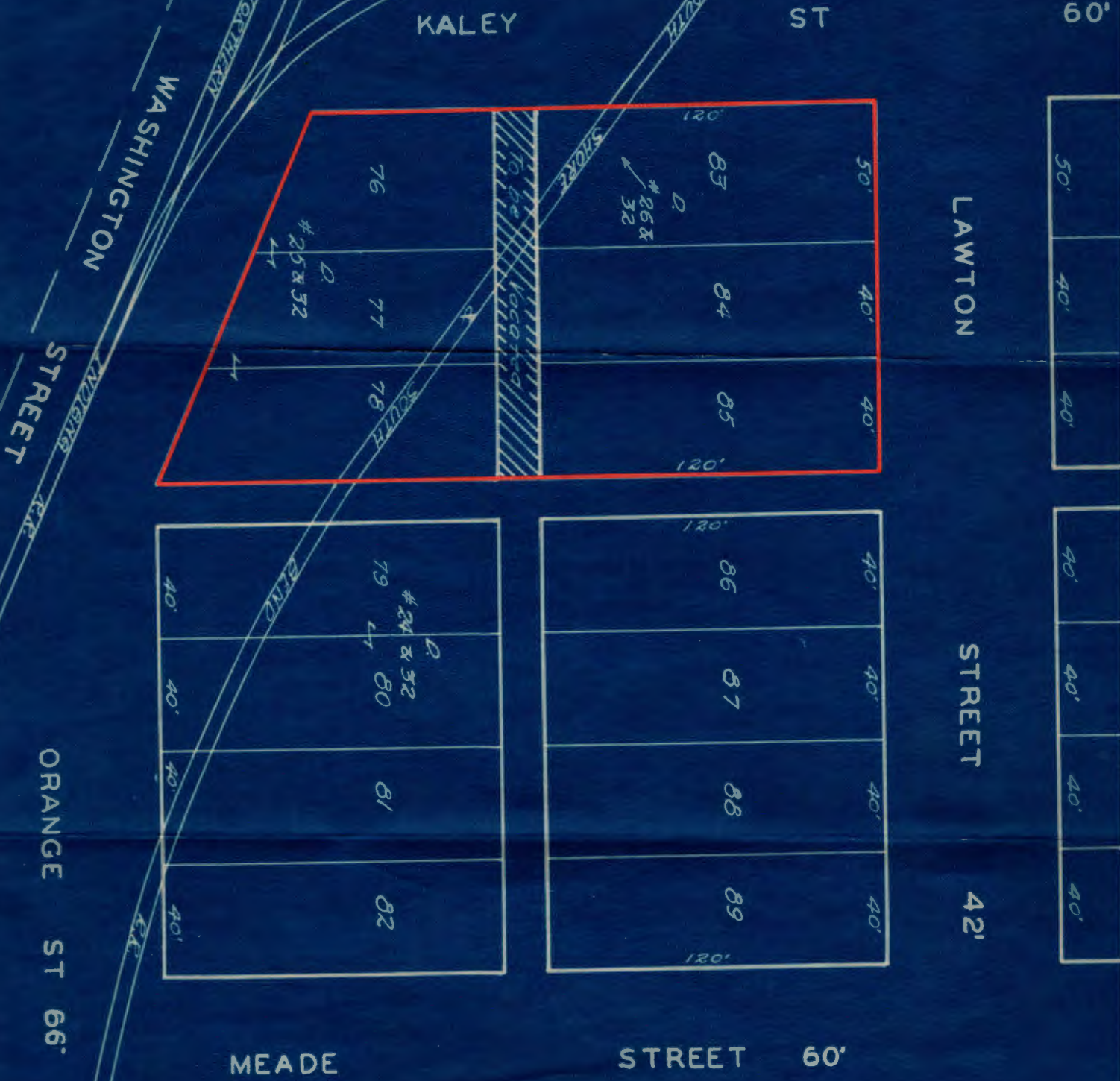

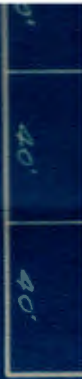

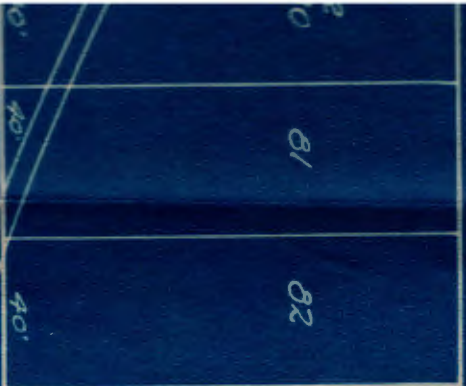


PLAT
