1 Meeting of Board of Public Works, City of South Bend

3 Hearing of Remonstrance against the Vacation
4 of Kendall Street, Chapin Street
5 and Catalpa Avenue

6 MR SLAUGHTER We have here a resolution to vacate certain
7 streets and alleys lying roughly southeast of Prairie ave-
8 nue, including Kendall street and Chapin street and Catalpa
9 street and the cross streets.

10 I understand the Studebaker Corporation has pur-
11 chased all the property within that area, and it is their
12 desire to move part of their factory over on that if the
13 streets and alleys can be vacated.

14 Now we are here tonight to hear what anybody has
15 to say for or against the ^{matter} ~~improvement~~ of vacating those
16 streets and alleys. We will be glad to hear everybody
17 on any side of the subject.

18 MR HAMBORSKY Mr. Chairman, President of the Board and
19 Members: Mr. Martin, Mr. Schwartz and myself were retained
20 to represent a number of the householders and owners of
21 real estate along these streets, and as you see there is a
22 number of them here; and they wish at this time to make
23 known their protest, for several reasons.

24 Now my personal feeling about this matter is
25 that we need larger factories in South Bend. As a matter of
26 fact, I encourage and foster the idea that Studebaker is
27 expanding; means more business to myself and colleagues,
28 more business to the city of South Bend, more employment.
29 We are in favor of all these things. Nevertheless, as a
30 number of our clients feel, it is not exactly necessary to
