Gentlemen:

We, the undersigned, owning property adjoining an alley running east and west and an alley running north and south in plat of Johnson's Subdivision of large lot 18 in Cottrell's First Addition to the town of Lowell now part of the city of South Bend, respectfully petition your honorable board that the alley running east and west and adjoining lots 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 in said subdivision; also a dead alley in the rear of lots A, 5 and 8 and being a strip of ground 14 feet north and south and 43 feet east and west, said strip of ground being off and from lot 8 in said addition, be vacated.

In consideration of said vacation, Mr. F. E. Hering, owning lot 5 which runs the full length of said alley running east and west, will dedicate to the city of South Bend from the west end of said lot 5 a strip of ground 53.3 feet north and south and 11 feet east and west. When said dedication is made, the south end of the alley running north and south will be 25 feet wide so that any one driving in said alley will have ample room to turn around and drive out.

The alley that we petition to be vacated has never been used by the public or any of the adjoining, abutting owners and merely appears as an alley on the plat.

The reason for the request of said vacation is on account of the erection of the Sunnyside Presbyterian Church and the parsonage which now stands south and east of said church. Said parsonage is to be moved west and south in order to give more space between the parsonage and church, and by vacating this alley, the change can be made in a satisfactory manner.

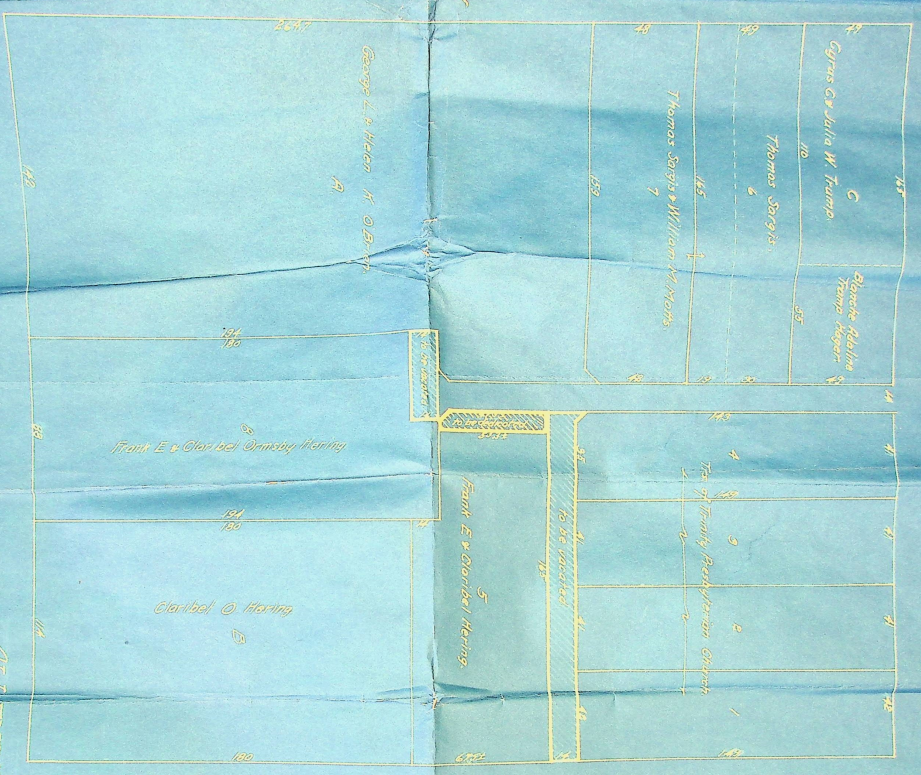
