COPY OF VACATION RESOLUTION

NO. 91, 1924

RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS OF THE CITY OF SOUTH BEND, INDIANA: That it is desirable to vacate the following:

The alley lying between Lots 581 and 590 Summit Place 3rd. Addition more particularly described as follows:- Beginning at the south west corner of lot 581 Summit Place 3rd. Addition, thence north along the west line of said lot to a point 14 feet east of the northeast corner of lot 590 of said Addition; thence west 14 feet thence south along the east line of said lot #590 to the southeast corner of said lot; thence northeasterly to the place of beginning.

The following property may be injuriously or beneficially effected by such vacation:

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of the 1st. alley east of Meade Street and the center line of Fisher Street; thence east along the center line of Fisher Street to the center of Olive Street; thence south along the center line of Olive Street to the center of the first alley south of Fisher Street; thence southwesterly along the center line of the 1st. alley south of Fisher Street to the center of Sample Street; thence west along the center line of Sample Street to the center of the first alley east of Meade Street; thence north to the place of beginning.

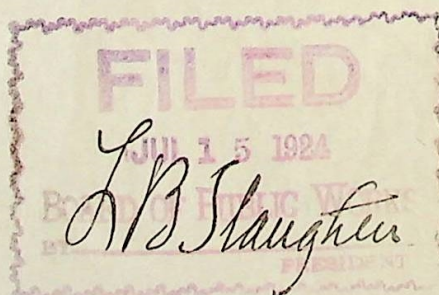
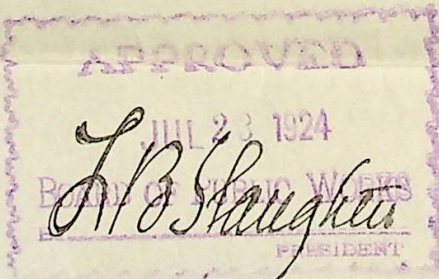
