- (1) The vacation would <u>not</u> hinder the growth or orderly development of the unit or neighborhood in which it is located or to which it is contiguous.
- (2) The vacation would <u>not</u> make access to the lands of the aggrieved person by means of public way difficult or inconvenient.
- (3) The vacation would <u>not</u> hinder the public's access to a church, school, or other public building or place.
- (4) The vacation would <u>not</u> hinder the use of a public way by the neighborhood in which it is located or to which it is contiguous.

The staff would recommend that these right-of-ways be vacated, subject to any utility easements that may be required. The vacations will also need to be subject to a turning radius easement at the intersection of the north/south alley and east/west alley for alley traffic from the south.
