

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PROPERTY:

The first East/West alley North of Bartlett Street from the East Right-of-way line of Lafayette Boulevard East to the East Right-of-way line of the first North/South alley East of Lafayette Boulevard for a distance of 179 feet and a width of 13 feet. 



Dear Board Members:

The staff has reviewed this petition relative to IC 36-7-3-13. It is the staff's opinion that:

- (1) The vacation would <u>not</u> hinder the growth or orderly development of the unit or neighborhood in which it is located or to which it is contiguous.
- (2) The vacation would <u>not</u> make access to the lands of the aggrieved person by means of public way difficult or inconvenient.
- (3) The vacation would <u>not</u> hinder the public's access to a church, school, or other public building or place.
- (4) The vacation would <u>not</u> hinder the use of a public way by the neighborhood in which it is located or to which it is contiguous.

The Staff recommends that if this alley is vacated that it be done so subject to the creation of any cross access or utility easements that may be necessary. The Staff would like to point out that it appears on the Sidwell map as if the alley has already been vacated.
