In accordance with Municipal Code Section 18-53.8, a **favorable recommendation** is being submitted to the Common Council concerning the following street vacation:

The first street to be vacated is a portion of Circle Avenue rom the Norfolk and western Railroad right of way to the south right of way line of Washington Avenue, for a distance of 770 feet, more or less, and a width that varies from 15 feet, more or less, and a width that varies from 15 feet to 80 feet. The second street to be vacated is also a portion of Circle Avenue from the Penn Central right of way to the north/south portion of said Circle Avenue for a distance of 400 feet and a width that varies from 20 feet to 35 feet.
