Upon review by the Engineering Division, Area Plan Commission, Economic Development, Fire Department, Police Department, Solid Waste Division and the City Attorney's Office, the following comments and recommendations were submitted:

The Fire Department stated that your neighbor at 326 36th Street would not be able to access their garage if this alley was vacated. However, if the resident at that address has no objections, then it should be okay. Engineering stated that a cross access easement will remain and the vacation should be agreeable with your neighbor. In addition, if these alleys are vacated, they are done so subject to any utility easements that are necessary.




