

Portions of Prairie Avenue, East of Scott Street and West of Chapin Street.


Engineering recommended approval of this vacation subject to the completion of an alternative route and revisions to the existing curb openings to accommodate two way traffic in the north half of the roadway.

RE: Right-of-way Vacation – Generally described as Prairie Avenue from Chapin Street to Scott Street.

Dear Board Members:

The staff has reviewed this petition relative to IC 36-7-3-13. It is the staff's opinion that:

- (1) The vacation *would* hinder the growth or orderly development of the unit or neighborhood in which it is located or to which it is contiguous.
- (2) The vacation *would* make access to the lands of the aggrieved person by means of public way difficult or inconvenient.
- (3) The vacation *would not* hinder the public's access to a church, school, or other public building or place.
- (4) The vacation *would* hinder the use of a public way by the neighborhood in which it is located or to which it is contiguous.

The Staff recommends that this vacation not be effective until additional right-of-way is dedicated and a new road is built. According to State Statute (36-7-3-12), the petitioner must be an owner of or an interested party in any lots contiguous to the right-of-way. The Staff suggests the petitioner verify that they meet these criteria prior to any action being taken.


