AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PROPERTY:

The street to be vacated is Frances Street from the North right of way line of Colfax Avenue to the first North/South alley North of Colfax Avenue for a distance of 198 feet and a width of 66 feet. Additionally, an area 45 feet north of the south right of way of Luther Court and 23 feet west of the east right of way line of Frances Street. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE AND INTENT

The staff has reviewed this petition. It is the staff's opinion that:
