
Engineering submitted a favorable recommendation, subject to providing public ingress/egress to 21st Street through the proposed parking lots.


If you decide to proceed with your request to the Common Council, please address the recommendations and provide solutions for the alley vacation.

The staff has reviewed this petition relative to IC 36-7-3-13. It is the staff's opinion that:
