The Board of Public Works reviewed your request to vacate the above right-of-way at its July 9, 2007 meeting.

The City Engineer stated that since the proposed vacation is not closing a street or right-of-way, does not hinder growth or orderly development and would not deny access to adjacent property, the petition does not need to go through the normal review by other City agencies. This portion of the right of way was dedicated as public right-of-way by INDOT during the construction of the US 20/31 By-Pass.
