### AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PROPERTY:

"The alley to be vacated is described as the first north-south alley West of Main Street and South of Colfax Avenue. The portion to be vacated begins at the southwest corner of lot number 236 in the original plat of the City of South Bend to the north 131 feet, to the west 10 feet, to the south 131 feet and returns to the east 10 feet to the point of beginning."

#### STATEMENT OF PURPOSE AND INTENT

Pursuant to Indiana Code Section 36-7-3-12, the Common Council is charged with the authority to hear all petitions to vacate public ways or public places within the City.

The following Ordinance vacates the above described public property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH BEND, INDIANA, as follows:

SECTION I. The Common Council of the City of South Bend having held a Public Hearing on the petition to vacate the following property:

The alley to be vacated is described as the first north-south alley West of Main Street and South of Colfax Avenue. The portion to be vacated begins at the southwest corner of lot number 236 in the original plat of the City of South Bend to the north 131 feet, to the west 10 feet, to the south 131 feet and returns to the east 10 feet to the point of beginning.

Hereby determines that it is desirable to vacate said property.

SECTION II. The City of South Bend hereby reserves the rights and easements of all utilities and the Municipal City of South Bend, Indiana, to construct and maintain any facilities, including, but not limited to, the following: electric, telephone, gas, water, sewer, surface water control structures and ditches, within the vacated right-of-way, unless such rights are released by the individual utilities.





Some conflicting information on maps received from the city has slowed us down some, but after my last conversation with Tony Molnar at the Engineering Department, we understand that the alley is indeed owned by the city (contrary to a notation on one of the maps we found).

We are currently against the idea of vacating the alley as it would totally cut off our legal access to the back of our restaurant. We prefer to leave our garden in the alley under the sidewalk cafe provision with a variance that allows us to leave it up at night and year round as requested in our application. (This was approved last year per a letter from Linda Martin stating that we needed to also take care of a dangling wire on the back of the building.) The pergola in the alley conforms with the drawing that was submitted and approved by Public Works last year. We completed two applications and paid for two permits last year (one for the front sidewalk and one for the back alley), and paid for two permits again this year. If the sidewalk cafe avenue is not satisfactory, is there another avenue that would allow encroachment on public property?

Both Fiddler's and Oyster Bar are still receiving deliveries through the garden to our back doors, and the fire marshal has inspected and approved the structure. At this point, I need to know if there are any other issues with the garden that I need to address. We have invested over \$10,000 in the paving and pergola. It has proven extremely popular with our patrons and we would very much like to keep it. Please advise what else we need to do.
