
Therefore, the Board of Public Works submitted a favorable recommendation for the vacation of this alley.

- The vacation would not hinder the growth or orderly development of the unit or neighborhood in (1) which it is located or to which it is contiguous. It is our understanding that the alley is purposed to be vacated for future development.
- The vacation would not make access to the lands of the aggrieved person by means of public (2) way difficult or inconvenient. The east/west alleys on either side no longer exist.
- The vacation would not hinder the public's access to a church, school, or other public building or (3)place. This alley does not access a church, school, or other public building or place.
- The vacation would not hinder the use of a public way by the neighborhood in which it is located (4) or to which it is contiguous.
