AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PROPERTY:

The first E/W alley South of Colfax Avenue from LaFayette Blvd. to the first N/S alley.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE AND INTENT

Pursuant to Indiana Code Section 36-7-3-12, the Common Council is charged with the authority to hear all petitions to vacate public ways or public places within the City.

The first East/West alley South of Colfax Avenue from the East right of way of line of LaFayette Blvd. to the first North/South alley for a distance of 165 feet and a width of 10 feet. Being a part of Knoblock's Subdivision and a Part of the Original Plat of South Bend, City of South Bend, Portage Township, St. Joseph County Indiana.






