AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PROPERTIES:

All Public Alleys & Streets bounded by Kemble Street on the West, the Norfolk & Southern Railroad (Old Penn Central RR) on the North, Scott Street on the East and Indiana Avenue on the South all in the City of South Bend, Indiana,

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE AND INTENT

Pursuant to Indiana Code Section 36-7-3-12, the Common Council is charged with the authority to hear all petitions to vacate public ways or public places within the City.

The following Ordinance vacates the above described public property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH BEND, INDIANA, as follows:

SECTION I. The Common Council of the City of South Bend having held a Public Hearing on the petition to vacate the following properties:

- The first North-South Public Alley East of Kemble Street running for a distance of 411 feet more or less from Indiana Avenue on the South to the Norfolk & Southern Railroad (Old Penn Central RR) on the North and having a width that varies from 7 feet to 14 feet.




