QUIT-CLAIM DEED

This Indenture Witnesseth, That Ferdinand Holstein and Herman Holstein, both single and of full age, of St. Joseph County, State of Indiana, convey and quit-claim to the City of South Bend, a Municipal Corporation, of the State of Indiana for the sum of Three Thousand Six Hundred Ninety-eight and 04/100 Dollars (\$3698.04), the following described real estate in St. Joseph County, State of Indiana, to-wit:

A lot or parcel of land Forty feet (40) in width taken off of and from the entire South ends of both of the following parcels, to-wit: Lot No. 5, and Seven and two-thirds (7-2/3) feet off of and from the West side of Lot No. 4, all in William S. Anderson's Sub-division, in the city of South Bend,

to be used as a part of Sample Street in said city.

And it is a condition of this deed that the remainder of said lots now owned by said grantors shall not be assessed further for the widening of Sample Street.
