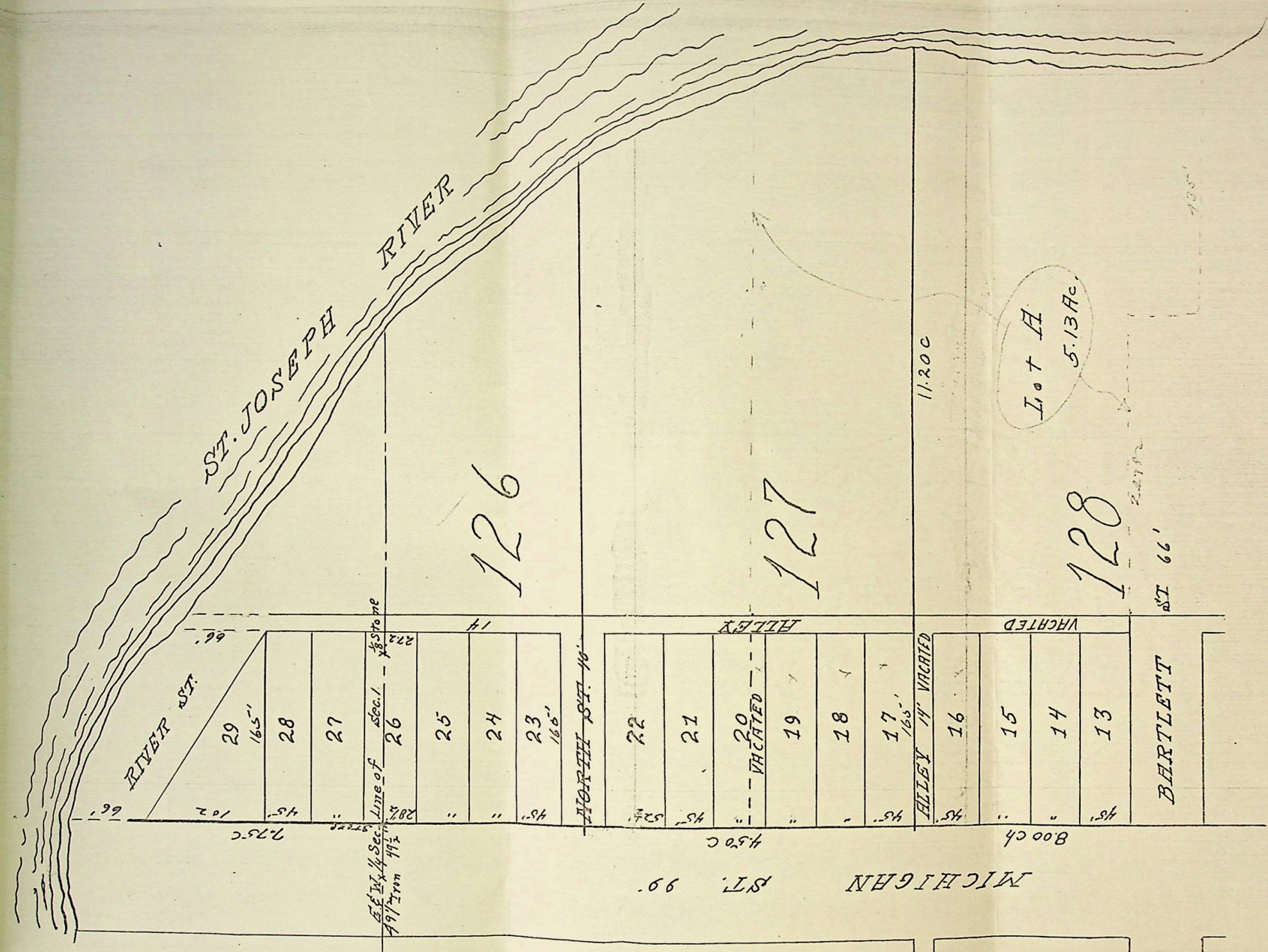

To The Municipal City of Summit Beul

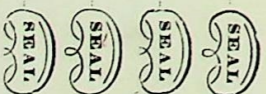
of St Joseph County, in the State of Indiana heirs and assigns,
