of St. Joseph County, in the State of Indiana, for and in consideration of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration ~~XXXXXX~~, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the following described Real Estate in St. Joseph County in the State of Indiana, to-wit: A parcel of land bounded by a line running as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point six hundred (600) feet east of a point in the north and south center line of Section Thirty-three (33), Township Thirty-eight (38) North, Range Two (2) East, distant south one thousand seven hundred fifty-five (1755) feet from a stone in the center of said Section; thence south one hundred sixty-one (161) feet; thence east twenty-seven (27) feet; thence north one hundred sixty-one (161) feet; thence west twenty-seven (27) feet to the place of beginning; and being the east twenty-seven (27) feet of grantor's land.

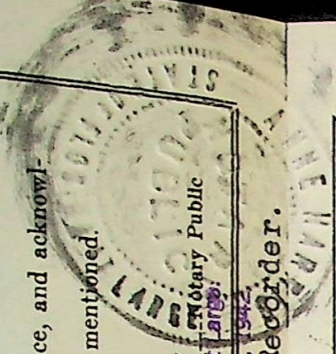
