AGREEMENT OF EASEMENT

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This Agreement made and entered into this day

of June, 1963, by and between the civil city of

South Bend, Indiana (hereinafter referred to as "City"), First

Bank and Trust Company of South Bend, as Trustee of the Joyce Krill

Goff Trust, and as guardian of David Barthel, Jr., Joyce Krill

Goff and Harvey Goff, her husband, Nicklas F. Krill and Maria I.

Krill, his wife, William L. Krill and Dorothy V. Krill, his wife

(hereinafter referred to as Grantors).

WHEREAS; the City desires to use for general street purposes, a portion of the Grantors' property, and

WHEREAS, the Grantors hereto are desirous of having the City so utilize said property for general street purposes, NOW, THEREFORE, WITNESSETH, that for and in consideration of One (\$1,00) Dollar in hand paid the Grantors, by the City, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and of the mutual considerations, and conditions hereinafter stated, the Grantors hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and warrant to the extent of their interest to the City, to have and to hold forever. a perpetual right-of-way and easement, including the perpetual right to enter upon the real estate hereinafter described with the right, privilege and authority of the City, its assigns. lessees, and contractors, to grade, level, fill, drain, pave, build, maintain, repair, and rebuild a road or highway together with such bridges, culverts, ramps, cuts, sidewalks and curbs, as may be necessary, and to construct, maintain, install, repair, replace and renew water, sewer and other utility familities, and to use for general street purposes, and the further right to remove trees, bushes, undergrowth, and other obstructions interfering with the street, over, along, through, and across property owned by the Grantors situated in the Northeast Quarter $(\frac{1}{4})$ of Section Thirty-Three (33), Township Thirty-eight (38) North, Range Two (2) East, in St. Joseph County, Indiana. Said right-ofway and easement being more particularly described as follows:

ST. JOSEPH CO.

Beginning at the Northeast Corner of Section
Thirty-three (33), Township Thirty-eight (38) North
Range Two (2) East; thence South along the East line
of said Section a distance of Seven Hundred Fourteen
and Forty-five Hundredths (714.45) feet; thence west
a distance of Forty (40) feet; thence north along a
line forty (40) feet west of and parallel to said
Section line a distance of Seven Hundred Fourteen and
Forty-Five Hundredths (714.45) feet; thence east a
distance of Forty (40) feet to the point of beginning.
Said parcel contains Six Hundred Fifty-six Thousandths
(0.656) acres, more or less.

The City further agrees as follows:

- (a) To act in a workmanlike manner as expeditiously as possible so as not to interfere with the use of the Grantors: property and buildings.
- (b) To indemnify and hold harmless the Grantors of any damages, claims and judgments of any and all kind, by reason of any action taken, thing done or work performed by the City, its assigns, lessees, and contractors in the performance of work contemplated under this Agreement.

The Grantors further agree as follows:

(a) That they are lawfully soized and possessed of the aforedescribed tract or parcel of land; and that they have a good and lawful right to convey and grant it; that it is free from all encumbrances; and that it will warrant and forever defend the title and quiet possession thereto against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
