Angela Smith, Danch, Harner and Associates, 1643 Commerce Drive, South Bend IN 46628, stated that Bill *No.* <u>18-24</u> seeks to vacate the first (1^{st}) three hundred feet (300ft) of Boland Drive where it intersects with Portage Road, as there is no longer a street at the location, nor are there

any plans to change the street network of the location. This vacation will allow for the future inclusion of a subdivision on either side of Boland Drive.
