Questions From Council (Not Answered on the Floor)

Question #1 (Councilmember Rachel Tomas Morgan): What is the City's status regarding the rebuilding of our streets?

Question #2 (Councilmember Rachel Tomas Morgan): Can the number of miles of roads paved and repaired each year be made available?

Questions From the Public (Not Answered on the Floor)

None.

Here is a quick update on the Rebuilding Our Streets Plan. Since the inception of the plan, the City will have addressed a total of 448 lane miles of roadway through paving, crack sealing, brick spot repairs, and microsurfacing. We are currently in the process of organizing another full evaluation of our roadways with StreetLogix to determine the updated average Pavement Condition Index for the City. We anticipate Streetlogix to perform the evaluation beginning in March 2025.

A breakdown per council district can be found below for all the paving work performed for each year. Note the table currently does not include any work for crack seal, brick spot repair, or microsurfacing. I want to reiterate that we start reconstructing the roads with the worst PCI scores and work until we are out of money.
