I have inspected the "hammerhead" cul-de-sacs as per your request and have found the following to be true.

## 27th Street

- 1. Clean plugged catch basin at northeast corner.
- Clean manhole in center of street and pour invert along with placing mortar around pipe.

## 28th Street

- Repair broken catch basin at northeast corner.
- Clean and repair manhole in center of street the same as above.

Both cul-de-sacs are concrete and the joints have an abundance of weeds growing from them. These sections under discussion now more so than the straight sections. If at all possible, it would be nice to have all cracks and joints cleaned and sealed. But it may be difficult in that the City hasn't maintained their sections.
