D., 1977 , between Dean Bolerjack , as Sheriff of St. Joseph County, in the State of Indiana, of the First Part, and City of South Bend , State of of the County of St. Joseph Indiana , of the Second Part, WITNESSETH That: Whereas, at the July Circuit Term of the St. Joseph , of St. Joseph County, Indiana, A. D., 1976, City of South Bend recovered judgment in said Court, in Cause No. G-9386 Taxing Unit BB
Date 10-28-77 , against Bessie H.
