EASEMENT

In consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars cash in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned hereby grant to the City of South Bend an easement for the following purposes: The right to enter upon the land described below and grade, level, fill, maintain and repair storm water retention facilities embraced within the easement as may be reasonably necessary for both sanitary and storm sewer purposes. The duration of the easement shall continue until such time as the Grantors or their successors or assigns deliver to the City of South Bend an easement granting the City other land or additional facilities adequate to replace this easement, which land or other facilities shall provide storm water retention facilities which conform to the then existing building code of the City of South Bend and which constitute a reasonable replacement for this easement.

This easement is located within the following described property:

A strip of land twenty-five (25) feet in width taken off of the entire north end located at:
