## DECREE AS TO ASSETS AND LIABILITIES

This cause comes on for hearing upon Husband's Petition to Settle Property. Husband appears in person and by counsel. Wife fails to appear and is defaulted. Evidence is adduced. And the Court having considered said evidence and It being otherwise duly advised in the premises now finds:
