WHEREAS, the City of South Bend, Indiana (hereinafter the "City"), is the owner of parcels of real property situated in the City of South Bend, St. Joseph County, Indiana, and being more particularly described as follows:

Our Department has been assisting Habitat for Humanity of St. Joseph County with obtaining properties in the Northeast Neighborhood for their "Blitz" this coming August. During this "Blitz" Habitat for Humanity plans to build five new homes in week for families of lower income. It was for this project that the Board of Public Works transfered four properties to Habitat several weeks ago. At that time, however, they still needed to find one additional lot upon which to build the fifth house.

Habitat for Humanity has now identified the fifth lot. This lot is owned by the City of South Bend. It is located on the southeast corner of the intersection of Cedar and Arthur Streets. The tax key number for the lot is: 18-5083-2914. A map shoeing th location of the property is attached.

Earlier this week I spoke to Mary Mueller as to the processs of having the lot transfered to Habitat for Humanity.
