**Common Council Climate Briefing (Part 2)**

A Climate Briefing (Part 2) is scheduled for this Wednesday, February 27, 2019 from 5:30-7:30 pm on the 4th floor of the County-City Building in the Council Chambers. The meeting is intended to provide an opportunity for the South Bend Common Council's Health & Public Safety Committee and the Utilities Committee members to hear information about local private and public sector actions already underway and to explore next steps for the Common Council and community on the issue of climate change.
