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## **Statement on the Passage of Resolution 4882-21:**

## A Resolution Approving the Director of the Community Policy Review Office Job Description

Following countless hours of research and deliberation, last night the City of South Bend took its first step towards the successful implementation of the South Bend Community Police Review Board with the passage of Resolution 4882-21. The Office of the City Clerk is taking immediate action to begin searching and screening candidates for the position of Director of the Community Police Review Office.

City Clerk Dawn Jones and the Office of the City Clerk staff recognize that the path to successful implementation will be hard, requiring compromise, collaboration, and deliberate and sustained engagement with community stakeholders. By continuing to champion transparency, the Office of the City Clerk will ensure that all of South Bend's voices are heard.
