Referring to the vacation of the present Sunnyside Avenue and the re-location of Sunnyside Avenue 50 ft. east of the present location, the property effected is as follows:

The present Sunnyside Avenue to be vacated is described as beginning at a point distant east 1350 ft. from the north west corner of Sec. 7. Tp. 37 north range 3 east, thence south to the north line of Jefferson Street, thence south easterly on the north line of Jeffersen Street to a point 50 ft. at right angles east, thence no parallel with west line and 50 ft. distant therefrom to the north line of Athe said section 7, thence west 50 ft. to the place of beginning.
