City of South Bend Indiana. Department of Public Works. Notice is hereby given that the board of public works of said city at a meeting of said board, held on the 9th day of January, 1906, adopted a resolution for the vacation of the following described property:

That part of the alley lying east and west along the north side of said lot 16 that lies between the northeast corner of said lot 16 and Harlin's Court.

RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS OF THE CITY OF SOUTH BEND, INDIANA: That it is desirable to vacate the following: All of Lot 5 except 7 feet along the east side, All of

Lots 6,7,8,16,17,18,19,20,21,22 and all of Harlins court from Washington street to the south line of Jefferson street, That part of the Alley lying east and west along the north side of said lot 16 that lies between the northeast corner of said lot 16 and Harlins Court,

All of Jefferson street lying between the west line of Harlins Court and the west line of Cherry street, in Harline Sub. except a parcel thereof bounded by a line running as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the west line of Cherry street and the north line of Jefferson street, thence running west to the south east corner of lot 22, thence south 16 feet, thence east to the west line of Cherry street, thence north to the place of beginning.

2 of the City of South Bend:

3 The undersigned freeholders of said City pray that  
4 the following part of Harlin's Subdivision of Bank Out Lot  
5 Eighty-two (82) of the Second Plat of Out Lots of the Town,  
6 now the City of South Bend, platted by the State Bank of  
7 Indiana, be vacated:-

8 All of Lots Five (5), Six (6),  
9 Seven (7), Eight (8), Sixteen (16), Seventeen (17),  
10 Eighteen (18), Nineteen (19), Twenty (20), Twenty  
11 One (21), and Twenty two (22), and all of Harlin  
12 Court from Washington Street to the South line of  
13 Jefferson Street;

14 That part of the alley lying east  
15 and west along the North side of said Lot Sixteen  
16 that lies between the northeast corner of said Lot  
17 Sixteen and Harlin Court;

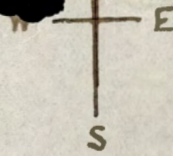

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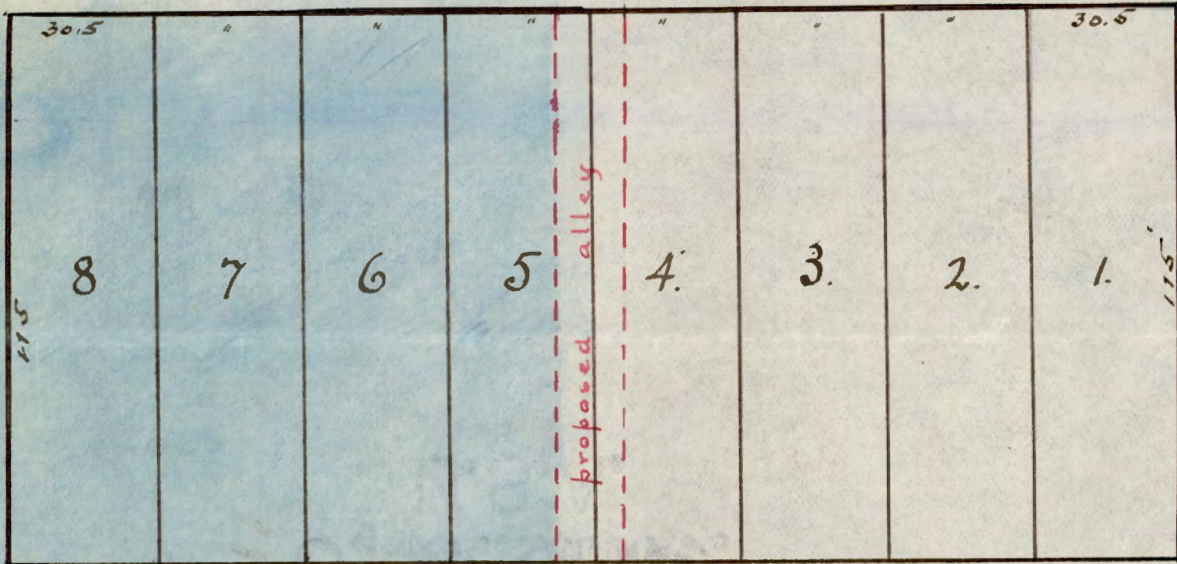




Washington St.



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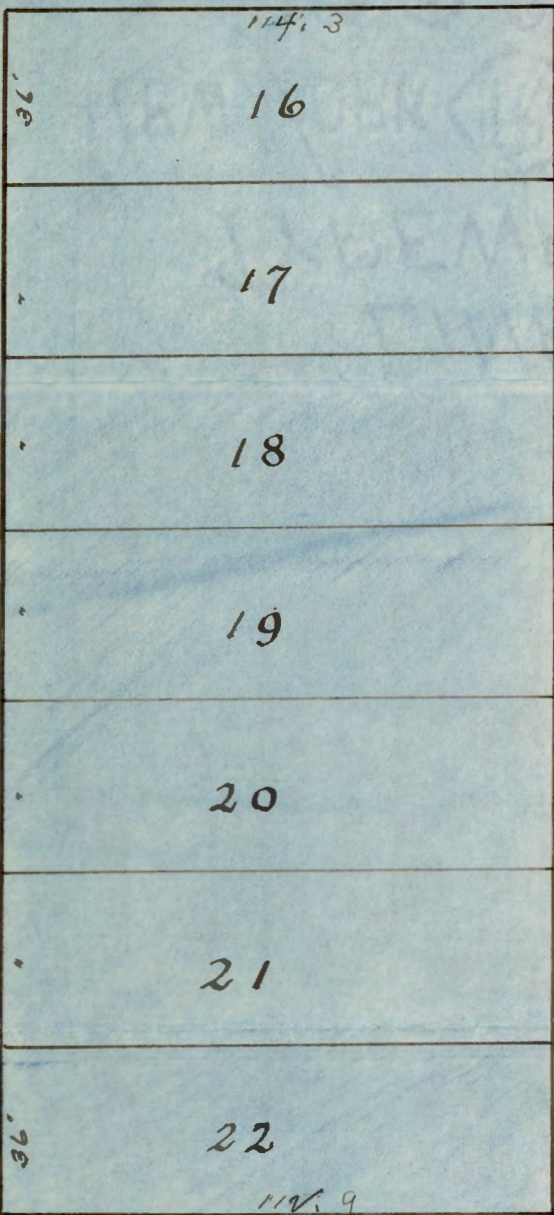

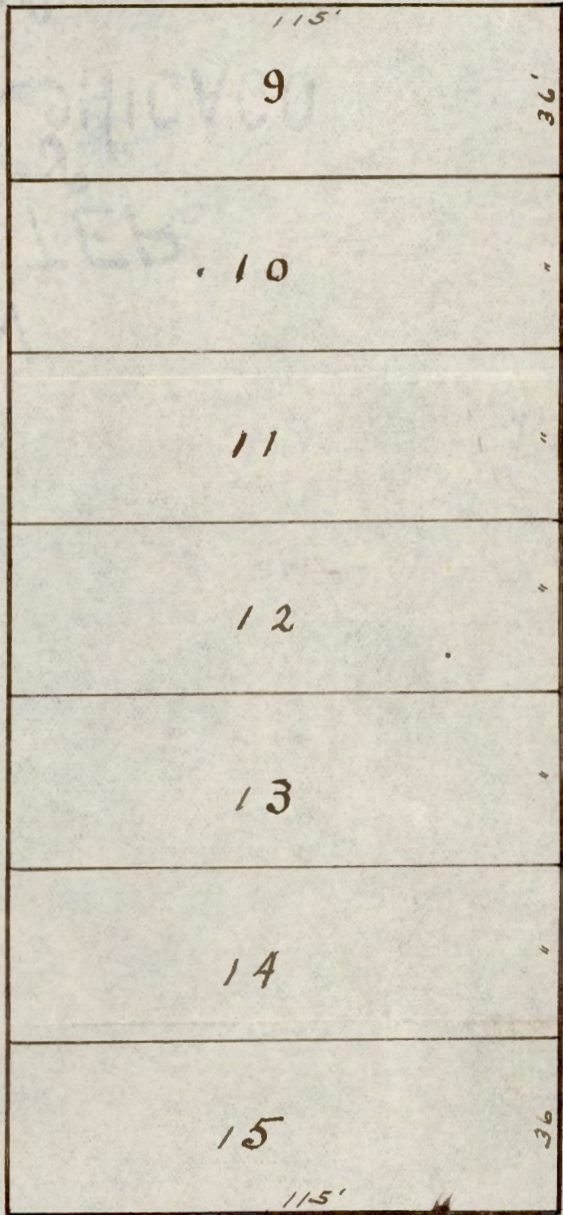
