COPY OF VACATION RESOLUTION.

No. 34, 1917

RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS OF THE CITY OF SOUTH BEND, INDIANA: That it is desirable to

vacate the following: A part of Scott Street, Leon Court and the first Alley north of Leon Court, more specifically described as follows:-

SCOTT STREET: Beginning at a point 14 feet north of the north east corner of lot 6 in Raff's First Addition to South Bend; thence south on the west line of Scott Street to a point 30 feet north of the south east corner of lot 7 in said Addition; thence east 20 feet to the east line of Scott Street; thence north on the east line of Scott Street to a point 20 feet east of the place of beginning; thence west 20 feet to the place of beginning.

LEON COURT: Beginning at the south east corner of lot 6 in Raff's First Addition to South Bend; thence west 123.6 feet to the south west corner of said lot 6 thence south 40 feet to the north west corner of lot 7 in said Addition; thence east 123.6 feet to the north east corner of said lot 7 thence north 40 feet to the place of beginning.

ALLEY NORTH OF LEON COURT: Beginning at the north east corner of lot 6 in Raff's First Addition to South Bend; thence north 14 feet to the north line of alley; thence west on the north of alley 123.6 feet; thence south 14 feet to the north west corner of of said lot 6 thence east 123.6 feet to the place of beginning.

The following property may be injuriously or beneficially effected by such vacation; Beginning at the intersection of the north line of the first alley north of Leon Court and the east line of the first alley west of Scott Street; thence south along the east line of the first alley west of Scott Street to the north line of Indiana Avenue; thence east along the north line of Indiana Avenue to the first alley east of Scott Street; thence north along the first alley east of Scott Street and said alley produced north to a point due east of the place of beginning; thence west to the place to the place of beginning.

Notice of resolution of vacation No. 34.

Notice is hereby given that the board of public works of said city at a meeting of said board held on the 13th day of February, 1917, adopted a resolution for the vacation of the following described property:

A part of Scott street, Leon court and the first alley north of Leon court, more specifically described as follows:

Scott street—Beginning at a point 14 feet north of the northeast corner of lot 6 in Raff's first addition to South Bend; thence south on the west line of Scott street to a point 30 feet north of the southeast corner of lot 7 in said addition; thence east 20 feet to the east line of Scott street; thence north on the east line of Scott street to a point 20 feet east of the place of beginning; thence west 20 feet to the place of beginning.

Leon court—Beginning at the southeast corner of lot 6 in Raff's first addition to South Bend; thence west 123.6 feet to the southwest corner of said lot 6; thence south 40 feet to the northwest corner of lot 7 in said addition; thence east 123.6 feet to the northeast corner of said lot 7; thence north 40 feet to the place of beginning.

Alley North of Leon court—Beginning at the northeast corner of lot 6 in Raff's first addition to South Bend; thence north 14 feet to the north line of alley; thence west on the north of alley 123.6 feet; thence south 14 feet to the northwest corner of said lot 6; thence east 123.6 feet to the place of beginning.

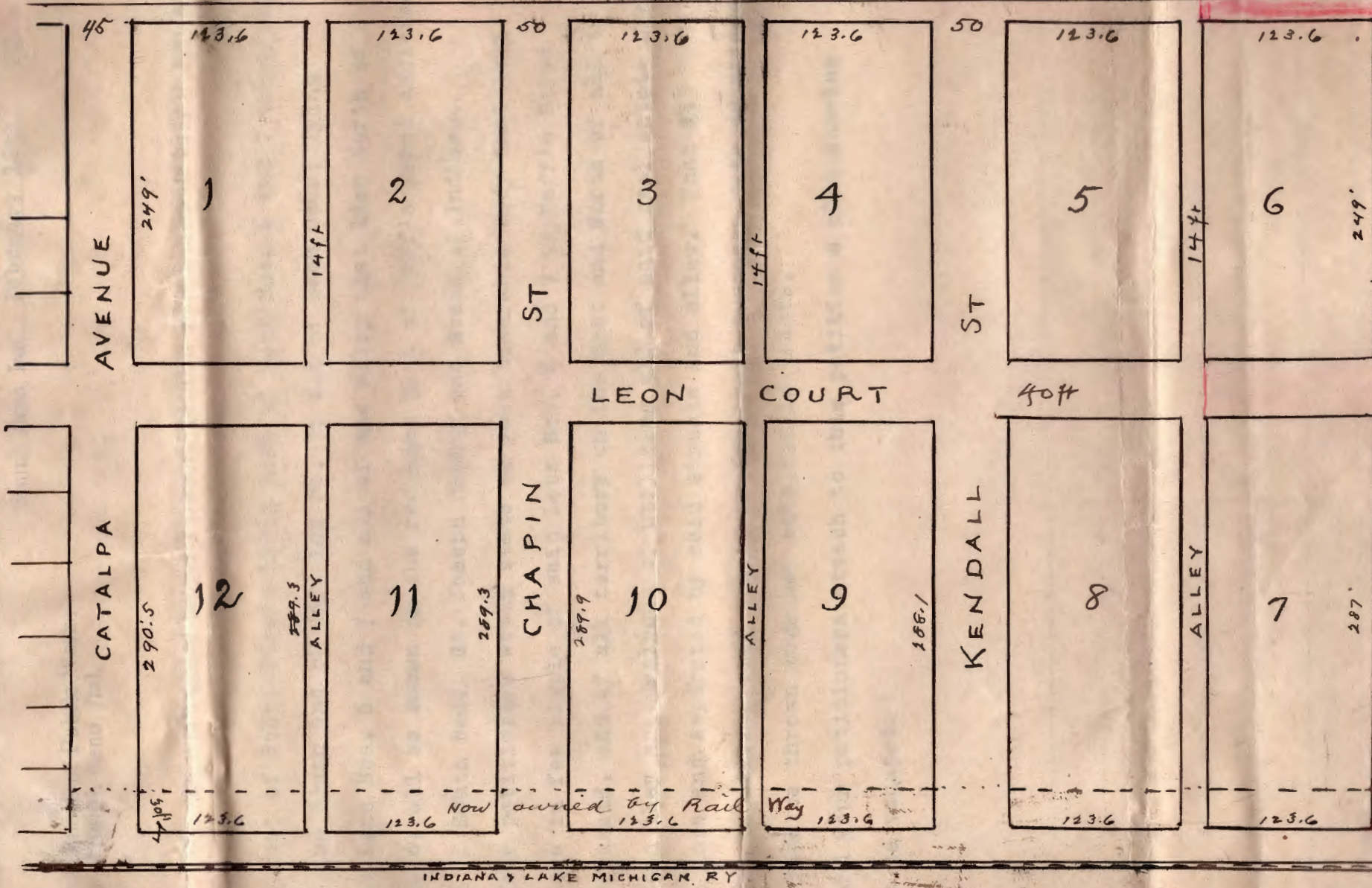

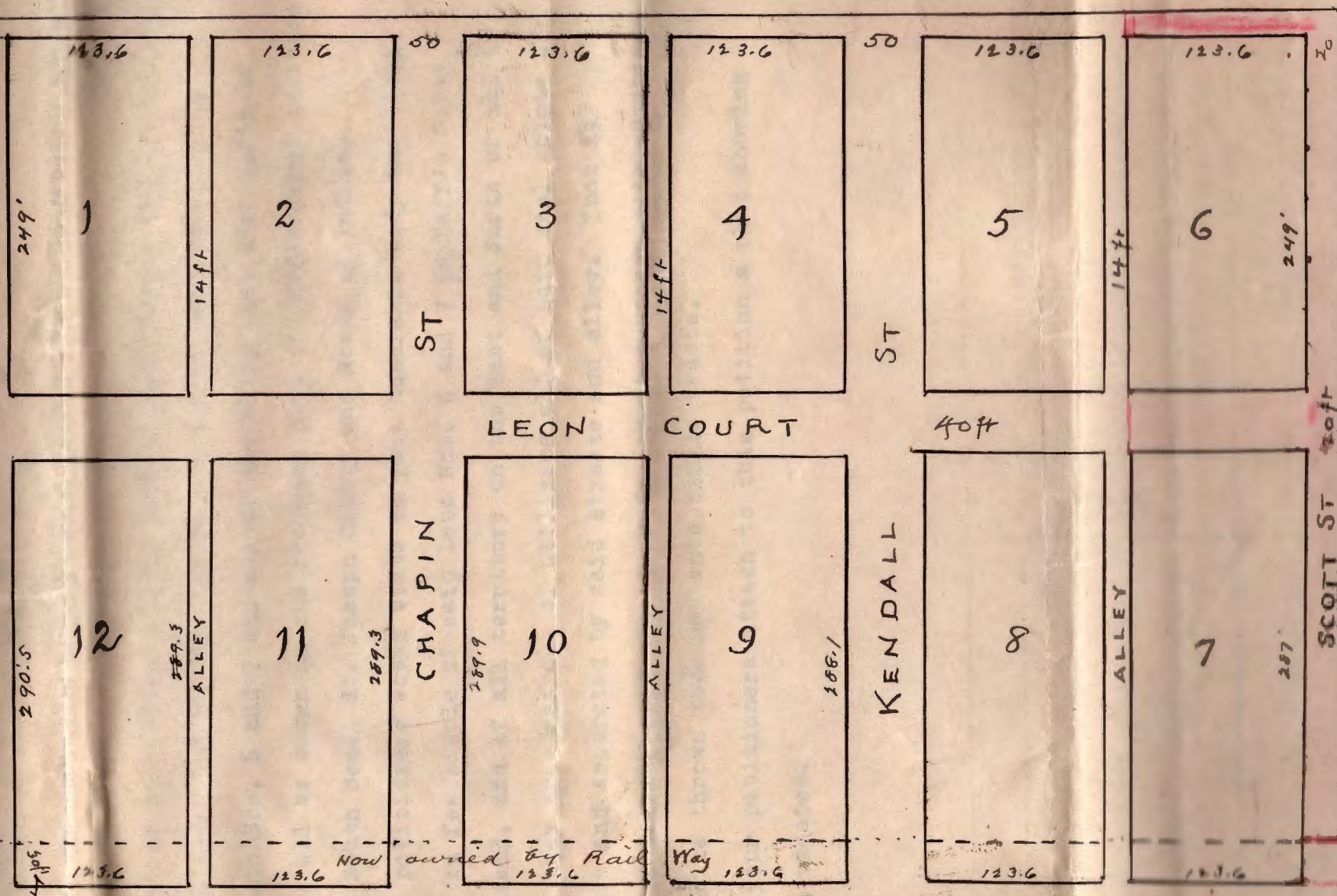
