Beginning at a point on the south line of Ewing Avenue where the west line of Main Street as platted in Bowman's Addition produced south intersects the south line of Ewing Avenue; thence south to a point 50 feet north of the north east corner of lot one (1) of Eckman's Oakside Plat in section 24 Tp. 37 N. R. 2 E. thence east 99 feet to a point 50 feet north of the northwest corner of lot 9 in said Oakside Plat; thence north to a point on the south line of Ewing Avenue 99 feet east of beginning thence west 99 feet to the place of beginning.
