The undersigned property owners, who are interested or affected by the proposed vacation of the following described portion of Kaley Street, in the City of South Bend, Indiana, to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the West line of Kaley Street and the East and West center line of Section 15, Township 37 North Range 2 East; thence South four hundred (400) feet; thence East Sixty (60) feet to the East line of said Kaley Street; thence North Four Hundred (400) feet to said East and West center line; thence West Sixty (60) feet to the place of beginning.

Hereby remonstrate against and object to the proposed vacation of said above described portion of Kaley Street for each of the following reasons, to-wit:

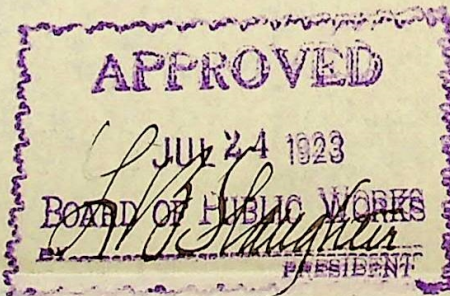
