There are eight (8) Remington 870 Marine Magnums. This model has been utilized and issued for over thirty years; these shotguns have sustained much wear and tear during their lives and are no longer fit for modern police usage.

There are two-hundred-and-sixty-one (261) Smith & Wesson M&P handguns. These particular handguns have been in circulation for seven years at the police department and cannot be issued to new hires. These handguns have been used extensively for training purposes and are not fit for duty usage.

The firearms will all be traded in to and collected by Vance Outdoors, one of the vendors SBPD consistently does business with, for a credit on future purchases.
